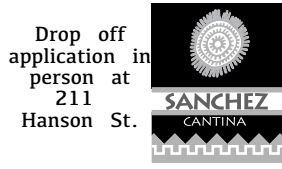

1969 News from the Whitehorse Star

Wolf Dog Attacks Four Year Old

A four year old girl is in serious condition following an attack by a "wolf dog" at Watson Lake on Saturday. Patricia Anne Glowa, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Alex Glowa of Watson Lake was flown to Whitehorse General hospital suffering from severe bites to the right groin and multiple other injuries. She has undergone surgery and was flown to Edmonton yesterday for further treatment.

The attack occurred at 12:30 p.m. Saturday by a wolf which is kept at Watson Lake for breeding purposes. Details of the incident were not immediately known.

The child was put aboard C.P. Air's northbound jet which brought her into Whitehorse in the record time of 25 minutes.
