1901 News from the Whitehorse Star

Space All Contracted

During the past few days the traffic department of the White Pass & Yukon Route has contracted in advance for all the cold storage space on its rail and steamer lines from Skagway to Dawson for the entire season.

The contracts held amount in the aggregate to 1000 tons of freight. This will be chiefly fruits, fresh eggs, poultry, fresh meats, and vegetables.

This is an entirely new business in Alaska transportation annals. The construction of three new steamers on the upper Yukon by the White Pass company, equipped with cold storage apparatus, was the last step taken in the matter of arranging or cold storage shipments this year by the traffic department.

The steamers equipped in this manner are the Ogilvie, McConnell and Dawson. Each will have a capacity of 20 tons. Skagway News.
